I hold a PhD in Linguistics from the University of Pisa, where I specialised in Phonetics, Corpus Linguistics, and Second Language Acquisition. In 2019, I defended a doctoral dissertation on the human perception and the computational processing of foreign-accented speech.

From 2018 to 2021, I worked at the University of Bologna, as a Post-Doctoral Researcher, a Teaching Tutor, and an NLP Lab Manager.

Until the 31st of January 2025, I worked a Researcher in Linguistics at the University of Pavia and the Scientific Coordinator of the Experimental Phonetics Laboratory.

Currently I work as a tenure-track researcher in Linguistics (*RTT, GLOT/01A*) at the University of Rome "Tor Vergata".

I have taught several B.A. and M.A. courses, such as *Phonetics and Phonology*, *Computational Linguistics*, and *General Linguistics*.

In 2024 (the second round of ASN 2023/2025 call) I achieved the National Scientific Qualification as an Associate Professor in the field *10/G1 Linguistics (GLOT/01)*.

My research deploys mixed-method approaches, by combining computational, quantitative and qualitative techniques. Some of my recent publications include articles on multimodality, non-native speech, political and (social) media discourse, and figurative language. Since 2020, I have coordinated (with Francesca Masini and Silvia Ballarè) the RadioCast-it speech corpus.

I am a member of the editorial board of the *Humanities and Social Sciences Communications* (Nature, Springer group), the *Bibliography of Metaphor and Metonymy- METBIB* (John Benjamins Publishing) and of the *OED Researchers Advisory Group* (Oxford Languages). Until 2022 I was the editorial assistant of *DIVE-IN – An International Journal on Diversity and Inclusion*. I have also served as a reviewer to national and international scientific conferences and journals.
